After meeting with the client one time, the professional wrote a letter to the court indicating that she had completed a thorough review of all court documents. At the time she wrote this letter, the professional had access to two court documents out of numerous documents filed with the court. Although the letter stated that the professional was not making a recommendation in the divorce proceeding, her comments, generalizations and insinuations about the client's ex-husband, the court and the client's minor child were clearly intended to prejudice the judge against the client's ex-husband. These statements were based almost exclusively on what was reported to her by her client during a single meeting without thorough research, including interviewing all the parties.	<b>Sanctions: 02/04/05 Consent Agreement</b> 1 year probation, ethics class, clinical supervision.

She also made a statement to the court regarding the father's behavior and its effect on the children that went beyond the scope of her responsibilities as a visitation supervisor. She also failed to file a written report with CPS, as required by state law, after filing a telephone report of possible child abuse.	<b>Sanctions: 02/04/05</b> <b>Consent Agreement</b> License deemed expired. If a future license is approved, may be immediately placed on probation and required to take a 6 hour seminar in law and behavioral health and be clinically supervised in areas of boundary issues and reporting requirements.

The professional's consistent pattern of unprofessional conduct, and his inability to understand the impropriety of his conduct, present a serious threat to the public health, safety and welfare. The professional's unprofessional conduct included the following: failed to truthfully disclose his work history to the Board and employers, failed to truthfully disclose previous employment terminations to the Board and employers, used abusive and aggressive language during a therapy session with a minor client, causing the client to react by physical self-abuse, used threatening and punitive language during phone conversations with a vulnerable client population, lacked empathy with and was judgmental and unsupportive toward clients, left an unqualified and unsupervised graduate intern alone to facilitate a group of adolescent sexual offenders, and tested positive for marijuana while employed at an agency providing substance abuse	<b>Sanctions: 07/13/05 License revocation and assessment of costs against the professional.</b>

Mary Lou Weyer	LISAC-App	N/A	The professional demonstrated a consistent pattern of unprofessional conduct, as documented by several previous employers, and an inability to maintain appropriate professional boundaries. The professional also acknowledged on-going serious mental health issues.	<b>Sanctions: 07/22/05</b> Denial of licensure application.
Donald Hopper	LAMFT-App	2005-0124 N/A	The professional sexually harassed a client and admitted that his conduct during sessions with the client was crass, inappropriate and indefensible. The professional failed to conform to minimum practice standards when he lost three years of client records due to computer failure where he failed to maintain an electronic and written copy of those records. Information from the professional's therapist also indicated that the professional was experiencing severe impairment.	<b>Sanctions: 02/08/05</b> Denial of licensure application.
