Move to approve the Social Work Credentialing Committee's recommendation to deny certification for unprofessional practice based upon a violation of A.R.S. §32-3251(10)(j), any conduct or practice that impairs the ability of the professional to safely and competently practice, based upon not complying with patient care rules at SHC and SMMH, and violations of A.R.S. §32-3251(10)(b), the use of fraud or deceit in establishing qualifications, A.R.S. §32-3251(10)(f), making use of statements of a character tending to deceive or mislead the public, and A.R.S. §32-3251(10)(i), any conduct or practice that is contrary to recognized standards of ethics in the behavioral health profession or that constitutes a danger to the health, safety and welfare of a client, as it relates to the NASW code of ethics 4.04, social workers should not be associated with dishonesty, fraud or deception and 4.06(c), social workers should ensure that representations regarding their qualifications, credentials, education and competence are accurate, based upon Ms. Jenkins misrepresenting information on Prehab and SMMH employment applications and on Prehab's background questionnaire, misrepresenting her termination to SMMH and Prehab and using fax coversheets that state CMSW when she was not.
