## SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT # 2006-03 CLINICAL SUPERVISION OBSERVATION

"This substantive policy statement is advisory only. A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that this substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties you may petition the agency under Arizona Revised Statutes section 41- 1033 for a review of the statement." A.R.S. § 41-1091(B)

A.A.C. rule R4-6-212(G) provides that "Effective July 1, 2006, an applicant must receive a minimum of ten hours of clinical supervision obtained during direct observation or a review of audiotapes or videotapes by the clinical supervisor of the applicant while the applicant is providing treatment and evaluation services to a client."

The Board interpretation of this rule is that an applicant who submits any supervised work experience acquired after July 1, 2006, must have at least ten hours of clinical supervision obtained during direct observation or review of tapes of the applicant providing treatment and evaluation services to a client
